## READ GENESIS CHAPTER 41

**TRY THIS:** Invite your children to act out this account. Help them to make the story come to life. For example, they might imitate the sounds of wind and cows in Pharaoh's dreams and the rumble of Joseph's chariot of honor.\*

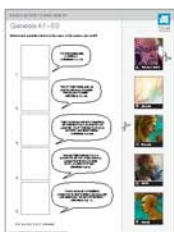

### PICTURE ACTIVITY

**CONNECT THE DOTS** Reread Genesis 41:42, 43. Then have younger children guess the three things that are missing from the picture, connect the dots, and color the picture.



### STUDY ACTIVITY

**WHO SAID IT?** Have older children match each statement to the person who said it.



### COLLECT AND LEARN

**BIBLE CHARACTER CARD** Read the profile. Ask the questions on the card. Using this card and the other cards you have, help your child to pick out Bible characters who were related to Jacob.
